Company History

We pride ourselves on our ability to turn big technology into easy to understand and operate solutions. Our systems are designed for economic development managers, Chamber of Commerce executives and their participating business members.

We launched research and development in 2005 after our founder, Richard Scully, was listening to Paul MacBeth on the radio who at the time was the Quincy Chamber of Commerce executive director. He was a guest on KNLF radio with Ron Trumbo... discussing projects that the Chamber was working on within the community. Our founder was truly impressed, but being a former software process development executive was curious how a Chamber with such a small budget could accomplish so much. During the radio show Paul also spoke about programs they wanted to develop and how they needed to create a cost effective online advertising plan for businesses.

After the radio interview, our founder contacted Paul MacBeth at the Quincy Chamber of Commerce to learn more about how they accomplish so much with so little. After talking to Paul, Richard determined that just maybe... Chambers of Commerce needed a new way (system) to manage the various operations associated with running and growing a Chamber of Commerce.

On this hunch, Richard began contacting various Chambers to find out how they managed so much on so little revenue... over and over he learned that most had nothing in place to help them automate much of this effort, or what they did have would simply manage the member records. There were no systems in place to develop a Chamber of Commerce, grow membership, manage projects and committees or significantly automate the process of placing an entire community online.

This was the determining factor Richard used in starting development of this program.

Having a successful software development background, former CEO of a San Francisco area based technology company, many years specifically in infra-structure automation, our founder began building a software proto-type for Chambers of Commerce.

With no former Chamber of Commerce experience, Richard relied heavily on input from Chamber executives and his past technology and usability knowledge. Richard also developed from the position of thinking in terms of selling the value of Chamber membership to a non-member.

With a very early version of the software in place, commitments from several Chambers to utilize it (yes we provided it for free to entice them), we began to implement and see daily use of the program. Almost daily Richard received calls and he just kept building and coddling this early software together to study usability. He knew at some point it would have to be re-tooled by an formal engineering team to support rapid growth, ten-of-thousands of businesses and incorporate the latest in security management.

Shortly after our first tests were made we were offered a considerable investment by one of the Chamber of Commerce executives we had been working with. With this investment in hand we launched "E Chamber Town USA" hence EcTownUSA.

EcTownUSA, LLC. remains as the holding company and provider of services, but in 2008 we decided to re launch our services for Chambers of Commerce under the new brand of Chamber Nation. For areas that do not have a participating Chamber of Commerce in place, we market under the branding of *Economic Development Program* with a formal launch planned for 2010.

Currently we support Chambers in over 30 states with thousands of users. Our recent launch of <http://www.chambersocialnetwork.com> proves that we're committed to helping our customers remain competitive. This is a very competitive landscape where Google, Yellow Pages, Yahoo, Apple and many others want to own the local business directory which is in direct competition with the Chamber of Commerce.

Monthly Reporting

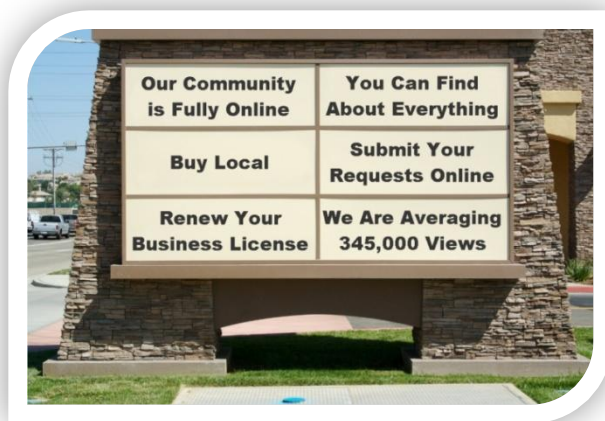
On the first day of each month every participating business receives an economic development program report. This information is very useful and may include additional information to members to help move the program further ahead every month.

The Business License Machine provides everything you need as a county or municipality to convert the license revenue stream into a reinvestment for economic development. Small portion of the collected fee pays for the automation needed to place the entire county online to improve commerce and sales tax revenue.

As the business license is processed and then approved the system will automatically invite the license holder electronically into the economic development program. From here business owners receive instructions on how to promote their business throughout the community and the nation. Each participating business qualifies for **FREE USA based support** so they can get the most from their business license investment.





We would like to suggest that upon issuance of the business license (or Chamber of Commerce Membership) you also provide the tools businesses need to promote their business. By providing the tools they need to properly advertise their business will help generate sales tax revenue for the city and improves the value of Chamber of Commerce membership is this program is actually managed by the local Chamber of Commerce. Imagine ***Students in Free Enterprise (S.I.F.E.)*** team or a local computer lab teacher at the high school becoming the solution to placing an entire community on line. With this technology the students won't need website development knowledge because that portion of the system is highly automated. Income to Non-Profit

Typically people don't like paying for their annual business license, but with the included advertising system and a dramatic increase in viewership by more prospective customers, the value of paying this fee is now obvious.

At the next business license fee assessment, determine if a small adjustment of \$7.00 +/- a year would be acceptable? You could use this revenue to make a monthly donation to the school who has committed to being certain that the community is fully optimized. The result would be competition between schools to secure this agreement with the City. They would have to assure that they would provide the best solution and how they intend to provide how this real work experience for students involved will in fact benefit the participating students.

Consider how much more competitive your community will be over the Internet and how sales tax revenue will increase as more people discover local solutions to their needs.

Patents are Pending

We have filed formal patents on our process technology for this program. During our patent research no prior art was found. Essentially we have re-designed the concept of data collection for website presentation through a "conveyor belt" concept that has multiple stations reducing the workload on any one person or organization.

The data collected will enable search engines like the membership directory, Area Search Engine®, Google® and many others to present much more information on individual participating communities.
