What constitutes a Preexisting business relationship?

The recipient of your email has become a member, made a purchase, requested information, subscribed to an event, responded to a questionnaire or a survey, or had offline contact with you.

What constitutes consent?

The recipient of your email has been clearly and fully notified of the collection and use of his email address and has consented prior to such collection and use. This is often called informed consent.

Isn't there a law against sending Spam?

The federal anti-spam law went into effect on January 1st, 2004 and preempts all state laws. While this new law will not stop spam, it does make most spam illegal and ultimately less attractive to spammers. The law is specific about requirements to send commercial email and empowers the federal government to enforce the law. The penalties can include a fine and/or imprisonment for up to 5 years.

How Company protects you from sending spam

Company is a permission-based membership automation company with email-broadcasting tool that follows the strictest permission-based philosophies:

Communication - Your organization clearly shows membership opportunities and registration page may state why you are collecting the member's email address, how you plan to use their address, and that you are following the embedded privacy policy. Additionally, by accepting our online services agreement you have agreed to use only permission-based lists (members) and never to sell or rent your lists.

Unsubscribe - Every email generated from Company contains an unsubscribe link which allows your members to opt-out of future emails and automatically updates your contact lists to avoid the chance of sending unwanted emails to visitors who have unsubscribed.

Identification - Your email header information is correct because it is pre-set for you by the Company. Your email's "From" address is verified and already accurately identifies your organization as the sender. **Contact Information** - all of your emails are pre-filled with your organization's contact email information.

How to protect yourself from Spam: Take the Spam Test

- Are you importing a purchased list of ANY kind?
- Are you sending to non-specific addresses such as: sales@test.com, business@test.com, webmaster@test.com, info@test.com, or other general addresses?
- Are you sending to distribution lists or mailing lists which send indirectly to a variety of email addresses?
- Are you mailing to anyone who has not explicitly agreed to join your membership mailing list?
- Does your email's subject line contain false or misleading information?
- Does your email fail to provide a working link to unsubscribe?

• Are you failing to process any unsubscribe requests that come to you via a "reply" to your email within 10 days or the request that did not use the provided unsubscribe link?

ATTACHMENT A - Information Service Access, Copyright and Privacy Policies

User ID's

A unique USER-ID will be issued to each individual that accesses the Membership Management System ("PMP"). Passwords will be chosen and entered into the system by the User.

PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN A USER-ID

- A User-ID Request is to be filled out online (member access request) for each individual who requires access to the PMP.
- The access issued to the individual will be set to "Member Level" only. Only the system administrator for the particular group grants approval for increased access levels.

PROCEDURE TO CHANGE ACCESS LEVEL

If it is necessary to obtain additional access to Menus and/or Programs, a User-ID Request to the system administrator for a specific group must be made and approved by the appropriate person in charge of any member group.

USER-ID AND PASSWORD POLICIES

- Individuals are responsible for all procedures processed with the USER-ID issued to them.
- Passwords will be reset periodically.
- Passwords must be at least 8 positions in length and must contain at least one (1) number.
- Passwords are NOT to be written down.
- Passwords are NOT to be given out to others.
- Make your password easy to remember.
