Base of operations for Green Zebra Adventures is in the Fort McDowell mountain preserve. > Taliesin West Tour Minimum 20 people \$95 per person



Constructed in 1937 from rocks and sand gathered from the desert floor, Taliesin West is now a National Historic Landmark. Initially, Taliesin West was designed as a winter home for Wright's Wisconsin school. Students at Taliesin lived in tents and simple shelters, and now, over 50 years later, still do! In keeping with its original design, the site serves as a living, working, educational facility to this day. Noted for its unusual form, this architectural masterpiece is an excellent example of the way in which Frank Lloyd Wright attempted to harmonize his creations with their natural surroundings.

Enjoy an extensive "Behind The Scenes" tour where you will have an opportunity to talk with Wright associates, visit the dramatic living room and cabaret theatre, walk to the historic sun cottage and more.

The newly-restored living quarters and the dramatic Taliesin West living room (called the "Garden Room" by Wright) are the highlights of this tour. The living room was the social gathering place for Wright and his many guests. Sit in Wright-designed furniture and experience firsthand the drama of being a guest in Wright's famous home.

After lunch with the WBFI group at 11:30, meet at the flagpoles to board your transportation. Round trip transportation is included in the \$95 per person fee. Bus will return to the Resort following the activity.
